

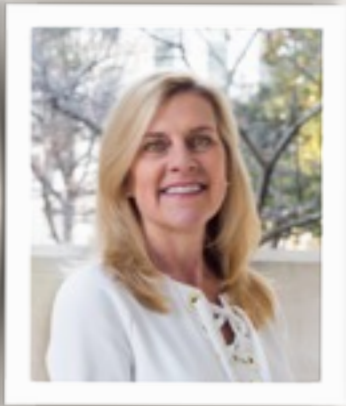

## **“Addressing the Crisis Culture: Human Trafficking, Opioid Abuse, and Criminal Gangs”**

### **HUMAN TRAFFICKING**

The GRACE Commission, Georgians for Refuge, Action, Compassion, and Education, co-chaired by the first lady, is working to find ways to combat the problems of human trafficking in the State of Georgia. GRACE Commission will be comprised of public officials, law enforcement, organizations, faith-based institutions, and experts on the subject matter. The Anti-human Trafficking Protective Response Act is passing through the Georgia Legislature and aims to fight the growing threat of modern day slavery in Georgia.

### **OPIOID EPIDEMIC**

Public health officials have called the current opioid epidemic the worst drug crisis in American history. Georgia is among the top 11 states with the most opioid overdose deaths, and 55 Georgia counties have an overdose rate higher than the national average. A newly created task force is unique in that it is open to all Georgians. “It’s time to bring everyone to the table on this issue.”

### **CRIMINAL GANG ACTIVITY**

From Georgia’s Anti-Gang Network to “Stop and Dismantle”, cooperation has come from federal, state and local partnerships to combat criminal gang activity in Georgia. “At the end of the day, the law-abiding people of our state deserve freedom from fear, and to do so, we must re-dedicate ourselves to disrupting all gang networks that are infiltrating our communities with violent crime and will stop at nothing to turn a profit.” In America, nearly half of all violent crimes are gang-related.
